Join us in this comprehensive 2 day workshop where we'll be exploring the plasticity of sheet metals through raising and chasing. This method is designed to keep the relative thickness of the material consistent to the original thickness, allowing the chaser to save material for sculpture and dramatic undercuts without losing the inherent strength of the material.

This course isn't very long so we'll be moving fairly quickly. Not to worry, whether you are brand new to chasing or an old hand at the chisel, the projects are designed to move at your own pace. The workshop will begin with an easy warm up project to allow everyone to acclimate to the tooling and we will go over methods and techniques. Following that, participants can choose from a variety of projects that Douglas has intentionally designed to guide you through working in steel and copper.
